
Parish Council meetings – 18th November 2021.

Belchford and Fulletby Parish Council Report from September Meeting 2021

The parish council meeting was held in the village hall and during the public forum members discussed the future of the VCC for St Peter & St Paul Church, Belchford along with the planning appeal at Flint Wood Farm. More daffodils are to be planted, there is to be a village green meeting in a few weeks and the survey results are to be reviewed, more trees are to be planted at the community woodland and a grant has been awarded from the Wolds Sustainable Development Fund towards installing an Observatory. We are currently waiting for the third and final quote for Full Fibre Broadband. The next meeting will be on Thursday 18th November.

The Hayes Furlong Wood is situated on the Belchford to Fulletby road and is open 24/7 to residents and friends of both communities. The trees planted last spring are doing well, despite the spring drought most have survived. This is due in no small part to the work group who fastidiously watered the trees on several occasions. The very same work group spent hours pulling ragwort plants. A big thank you to all involved.

Winter plans include building a natural Observatory, generously funded by Lincolnshire Wolds Countryside Service and planting more trees, some of which have been very kindly paid for by villagers, their family and friends If you haven't discovered this fantastic community asset yet, spare an hour and have a look; and finally, if you


