Parish Council Meeting Report Thursday 21st September

The meeting started with a public forum, where discussion included the state of the roads (various issues to be reported by the clerk to Fix my Street) a report from a Biodiversity group leading project on chalk streams and enthusiastic discussion on clearing the Ings Lane Bridleway.


The agenda included a reports from District Councillor D Simpson, the Village Green committee and an update on highway matters as a site visit has taken place with PT in attendance and LCC Highways representatives plus LRSP. The village was walked to inspect drains and road edges and road condition. A thorough Survey is to be carried out. Once the officer's report has been done he will contact us and the Lincolnshire Council.

It was noted that community woodland is now developing well and beginning to look like a area with trees, not a grassy field. The trees that have not survived the dry conditions of last year will be replaced and grant funding for deer protection of larger trees will be looked into by Cllr Smith.

The Neighbourhood Development Plan is progressing and will be available for residents and stakeholders to examine and comment on for 2 months from the 1st of October till the 1st of December.

Other things discussed were footpaths and rights of way, possible signage of the location and any service agreement of the village Defibrillators.

The strength of Village Volunteer efforts!

During two weeks in November, with the permission of the Landowners, a small group of volunteers from Belchford, led by Dawn Urry, Zach Henden, Dick Black and Peter Thompson, cleared the heavy growth of thorn bushes from a 500 metre section of the historic route of the Ings lane Bridleway, which links Belchford to the Bluestone Heath Road. This has made the bridleway properly passable again for the first time in 14 years. The flooding near the ford on Ings Lane has also been worked on by members of the same team, making this section walkable again. Many thanks to everyone who gave up their time to help with this project.
