

Belchford and Fulletby Parish Council Report from January Meeting 2022

The parish council meeting was held in the village hall and was well attended by councillors and public. The Neighbourhood Development plan has reached its next stage and was discussed in some detail during the public forum. This plan will enable our villages to have more of a say on future development in the parishes. Other topics discussed at this meeting included footpaths and the organisation of an event to celebrate the Queens Platinum Jubilee. One application has been received to the Belchford Public Purposes Charity Fund which cannot be dealt with until signatories have been changed with the bank.



Good progress is being made with the observatory shelter in the Community Woodland between Belchford and Fulletby. The frame for the walls has

been completed by a team of volunteers. The frame is being stuffed with donated brash to create a dense, wildlife-friendly windbreak. This work is also being done by volunteers from our villages.

Benches are being made to work with the observatory. These will include two reclined benches, designed for comfortable observing of the night sky. As a bonus, they will also work for sunbathing in the summer! Other, more conventional, benches will be made and fixed inside the observatory and outside where they will enable people to rest and soak up the views.

The observatory should be ready for use by the end of February.

Many parishioners and local people have purchased trees for the Hayes Furlong Woodland.

They have now been delivered and will be planted over the next couple of weeks.


