Annual Parish Meeting:

Was held on Thursday 22nd May, the outgoing parish council chairman Mr Peter Thompson read his report to the meeting. An electronic copy of this report will be made available to everyone in due course. Bus Shelters, notice boards and benches. This will be carried out over the coming months. Reports were received from some community groups including Fulletby Glebe Trust, Village Hall, Mothers & Toddlers, Those present also discussed the village green and the lack of play equipment, a suggestion of Belchford Public Purposes funds being used to support any installation of play equipment was raised.

Parish Council Meeting: immediately following the Annual Parish Meeting

Mrs Jill Newby was elected as the new parish council chairman. Mr I Goodall and Mr J Smith were elected as joint vice chairmen. Mr Paul Barnes volunteered to be the parish council representative on the village hall committee. Thanks were given to Mr Thompson for his hard work and dedication during his tenure as Chairman. Our new county Councillor Mr Alex McGonigle introduced himself to the meeting and District Councillor Simpson was also present and advised that he has community grant funds available. The village green AGM date has not yet been set and members expressed concerns and help is to be offered. The village signs are to be repainted and a budget of £80 was agreed. Highways matters were discussed including the condition of Lowfield Lane. The insurance policy is to be renewed and the Annual Governance and Accountability Return for 2024/2025 was completed. The July meeting will be held in the village hall on 17th.


