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Venue: Fulletby Glebe Field

The meeting was outside on chairs on the grass at Fulletby's Glebe Field. Seven parish councillors were present, one member of the public, parish clerk and both District and County Councillors.

Cllr Newby notified the meeting that our Clerk of long standing Karen Elliott will be sadly resigning in September and thanks was given to her for her service over the years.

Discussion began in the public forum on a project put forward by villager George Eke involving possible parish wide CTV surveillance to try to combat the rising instances of crime. County Cllr McGonigle said he will look into the legalities of any setup and any data protection issues.

Reports on a new position for the children's school bus stop was discussed, resulting in suggesting a winter time observation by the County Council would be requested to highlight the dangers of the current situation. It was noted that Belchford Defibrillator is to be re positioned over the next few weeks to the Village Hall arranged by Cllr Barnes and Village Vice Chair Rebecca Eke.

It was decided that Edward Goodall will be helping with re painting the village signs with Cllr Newby. Possible dog secure fencing at the Village Green was discussed, a kind parishioner has offered possibly funding this, Cllr Smith is going to discuss the matter with the Village Green Chairman James Hallam.

It was reported that the community Woodland has had the Observatory (The Twiglet) benches repaired by Cllr Goodall, and paths/seating area cleared by Cllrs Smith and Thompson.

A report was read out by the Cllr Newby from the Village Green Committee Chairman, this is available on the Parish Council Website to read.

Cllr Hockham agreed to produce the next Parish Council Newsletter and help with the recruitment of a new Clerk. There were no planning matters to discuss.

The meeting ended at 9.15 pm
