- DELIVERY OF THE NOMINATION PAPERS:** Nomination Papers must be **delivered by hand** to the Returning Officer, The Hub, Mareham Road, Horncastle, LN9 6PH, on any day after the date of this notice, on Monday to Friday between the hours of 10am and 4pm (excluding Bank Holidays), but no later than **4 pm on Tuesday, 4th April 2023**. It will be necessary for candidates to make an appointment with the Returning Officer in order that their nomination can be handed in by this deadline. - POLL:** If the election is contested, a poll will take place on **Thursday, 4th May 2023**.
