#### **Community Woodland Update**

The Community Woodland between Belchford and Fulletby is continuing to develop well. Most of the new trees that were planted in early 2022 have survived their first year. Sadly, a few larger beeches that were donated late in the planting season struggled with last year's dry summer and some of these have died. However, most of the young trees are doing really well and showing new growth this year. It is very encouraging to see new species of wildflowers establishing spontaneously in the woodland. The latest new arrival is a Spotted Orchid, which has emerged in the wet area at the lower end of the site. Unfortunately, the battle with ragwort has not yet been

won. Volunteer "Action Days" to dig out the ragwort before it flowers and sets seed will be organised soon.
