Parish Council Meeting Reports and Updates

Belchford & Fulletby Parish Council Report July 2023 from the clerk

The July meeting was held in Fulletby Church. During the public forum members of the public raised concerns about vehicles driving over verges. Our Chairman Mr P Thompson is keen to welcome members of the public to all parish council meetings. We also welcomed John Smith back onto the Parish Council and our new District Councillor Mr D Simpson. The council was invited to apply for a grant from his Councillors Community Grant Fund. Money raised from the recent Lane Letting Auction has been used to purchase football nets for the Village Green. The parish council discussed the condition of Ings Lane and also updates to the parish asset register.



Village Green Update

We've had a fab few months of events on the village green and we have been really supported by the community - thanks to all who have come along , or just pitched up on the day to help us out .

The car boot was a success- this time round we have mostly villagers selling, but car boot gurus have told us that we were fairly priced and that if we repeat the events regularly we will get a wider attendance . The next date is in the diary . We raised £152 - the butties and coffees being the major source of the profits (thanks to Nance and Zach for running the show !). Thanks to Dick for helping us set up - your gazebo skills put the committee to shame .

We are progressing with the funding for the play area- it's no small task, Nancy applied for a grant from the co op and we got £1000 - made possible by the villagers helping giving us their coop membership numbers . We are also using a crowd funding site called Space Hive to get some more donations - updates to follow . Nancy met with Doug Rodwell from Hemingway PC who gave us loads of ideas and tips on how to pull this project together .

Due to Nancy's efforts , we now have been chosen as Co op Community champion which means they will raise money for us from 3rd December to the end of March. So using your card in the Louth Co op will help tremendously .

Football posts are up and being used - great to see and thanks to the PC for supporting us with this . Particular thanks to Jacob for trying. them out, and scoring the first goal.

So next on the list is the rounders . The trophy is ready to be passed on , so please spread the word and get your team together As we always mention , feedback
