The parish council met remotely for the November meeting due to the Covid restrictions and matters discussed included agreeing a name for the community woodland and planting some trees in the community woodland, what to do about empty properties in our parishes plus several planning applications were discussed and our responses agreed. The budget for the forthcoming year 2021-2022 was agreed along with the precept for the same period which will remain the same at £2,940.
