The parish council met remotely in November meeting due to Covid restrictions, matters discussed included agreeing a name for and planting some trees in the community woodland, what to do about empty properties in our parishes plus several planning applications were discussed and our responses agreed. The budget for the forthcoming year 2021-2022 was agreed along with the precept for the same period which will remain the same at £2,940. We also need a new Trustee for the Belchford Public Purposes Charity, volunteers are to be requested via the next newsletter.
